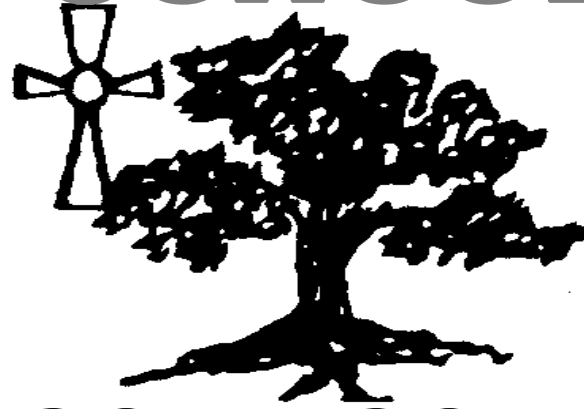

## **REGULAR SCHOOL SCHEDULE:**

**FIRST BELL: 7:50 a.m.**

**CLASSES BEGIN: 8:00 a.m.**

**MORNING RECESS: 9:55 - 10:10 a.m.**

**LUNCH RECESS: 11:55 - 12:30 p. m.**

**FINAL DISMISSAL: 2:30 p.m.**

- **FAMILY ENVELOPES** are distributed to students after 2:00 p.m. on Mondays (or the first school day of the week) and are to be returned the following day. Parents should review all information that comes home carefully, including the school's weekly newsletter (the "Bear Paw"), as it includes details about such things as up-coming events, changes in the schedule, and individual classroom requirements.
- **FAMILY ENVELOPE SUBMISSIONS:** If you want to have an item included in the Family Envelope or "Bear Paw" newsletter, it must be submitted to the school office for approval in "camera-ready", reproducible form via an email attachment in Word by Thursday at 10 a.m. of the prior week. All items appearing in the "Bear Paw" and Family Envelope are subject to approval and/or editing by the school principal, and all items/flyers/notices to school families are distributed at the principals discretion.
- **JUNIOR HIGH COVER SHEETS:** Cover sheets go home on the first day of the week with the Family Envelopes for students in grades 6-8, and must be returned the following morning directly to the homeroom teacher during homeroom. If a student is absent, it must be returned to the homeroom teacher the day the student returns. Cover sheets should not be brought into the office nor should they to be returned in the Family Envelope. Students turning cover sheets in late will receive a "Work Habits" referral from their homeroom teacher.
- **TARDY TO SCHOOL:** Class starts promptly at 8:00 a.m. Students should arrive by 7:45 a.m. each day (no earlier than 7:30 a.m.) to gather the materials needed to begin class ~ especially Jr. High students who need to go to their lockers. If you are not inside your classroom prior to 8:00 a.m. you must report to the school office for a tardy referral. Plan to leave the house earlier on rainy days, or during any possible road construction, to help avoid tardiness, and to help ensure a safe speed when driving onto campus. Any student not seated by the 8:15 a.m. bell is tardy.
- **"MEDICAL EXCUSED" TARDY:** Students coming to school late from a medical or dental appointment will be given an "Excused" Tardy only if they bring a note from the doctor or dentist within 24 hours of their appointment. (The note can be faxed directly from the doctor's office and must be a admit to school slip.)
- **ABSENTEE PROTOCOL:** Parents need to telephone the school office before 8:00 a.m. each day their child will not be at school (a voice mail message can be left at ext.0). Upon their return to school, a brief note must be sent to the (homeroom) teacher within 48 hours, which includes child's name, date(s) absent, and the reason. If the child feels better and comes to school mid-morning, the note should be brought to the school office. The school secretary will utilize our "auto-call" system to phone families after 10:00 a.m., who have not called in an excuse for their child's absence.
- **THURSDAY MORNING STUDENT ASSEMBLIES:** Students are expected to be at school on Thursday mornings by 7:50 a.m. for this assembly, which is usually located on the basketball courts. There is not an assembly held every Thursday: please check the SPBS Calendar.
- **PARENT VOLUNTEERS:** Remember to complete & turn in a "Volunteer Hours" slip whenever you help at school. Each volunteer is responsible to turn in their own hours. These forms are found next to the counter in the school office and on our school website. You must also sign in each time you are at school and wear a red "Volunteer Badge" at all times while on campus.
- **PARENTS & VISITORS:** For the safety of all students, SPBS is a "Closed" campus during school hours. All parents and visitors must check into the school office upon entering the campus. All visitors, including parents, must wear a red visitor badge while on campus. Thank you for your cooperation... and understanding. All visitors to SPBS are videotaped upon arrival, as a safety precaution.
- **ITBS Testing (Grades 2-8):** Please avoid scheduling appointments for students (i.e. dental or medical) during testing weeks indicated on the school calendar in October. It is counter-productive for students to make up testing, and they may also then fall behind in their other schoolwork.
- **SPIRIT DAYS:** Spirit Days are indicated on the SPBS calendar. Students who wish to participate in the designated Thursday "Theme Free Dress" Spirit Days are to bring 50¢ to their classrooms during that week. Student Council members collect the money from the students. All monies collected are then donated to the Catholic missions at the end of the school year, or used to purchase supplies for the "Bear Cave" (Student Store).
- **"DRESS" UNIFORM:** Whenever we attend Mass together as a school on Friday mornings, attend liturgies or services in the church, and/or at other times as noted, boys are to wear long navy Dennis Uniform pants, and girls wear their SPBS plaid skirts/jumpers. Please check the school calendar and weekly "Bear Paw" for Mass and paraliturguy dates and times to see when dress uniform is required.

### **SCHOOL HISTORY:**

St. Paschal Baylon School first opened its doors in September 1963, with an enrollment of 286 students in grades 1-6. The teaching staff consisted of four Sisters of Notre Dame and two lay teachers. In 1966, a second building was erected, and another class was added to grades 1-4 each year until 1970. At that time, the Archdiocese of Los Angeles directed all schools to eliminate the second class of each grade, in order to curb rising school administration costs. As classes were eliminated at SPBS, classrooms were converted into accelerated and resource classrooms, a school library, and a music/extended care room. A computer lab was built, and it opened in the fall of 1989. A kindergarten classroom and new faculty lounge were added in the fall of 1993. In 1997, after 35 years of service, the Sisters of Notre Dame withdrew as an order from administering SPBS, due to a shortage of vocations. SPBS continues to be a Catholic parochial school, whose Catholic lay principal, Mrs. Suzanne Duffy, has now served as Principal for 15 years. Accelerated classes for grades 6-8 were implemented in the fall of 1997. The Jr. High science lab was added in the fall of 1998 as part of the renovation and remodeling of the "upper building". Air conditioning was also installed in all of the classrooms at that time. During the summer of 2000, the patio/lunch area was re-built: a new patio cover was installed and new concrete was poured between the school buildings. The Health Room was completely renovated during the summer of 2001, and is now also an office and work/copy room. A new P.E. equipment shed was installed near the sports field, in May of 2004. During the summer of 2004 the lower grades' building was completely renovated: the last remaining asbestos was removed; the bathrooms were renovated; and a room was built for small-group student instruction. During the summer of 2005, the SPB hall floor was retrofitted with new state-of-the-art athletic flooring. A new upgraded surround-sound system was also installed, for use with our school and parish fine arts productions held in the hall. Summer 2006 saw the complete renovation of the SPBS library, with the addition of new technology and computers for students; and bookshelves, to accommodate our growing book inventory, along with new carpet. During the summer of 2007, we added a much needed Art/Storage Room to SPBS. During the summer of 2009, we upgraded counter tops in the media rooms and installed new carpet in the upper building, and during the past summer of 2010 we refurbished/repainted the large patio roof; added new carpet to the computer lab; and continued to install Smartboards and digital technology in the classrooms. In 2011, 21 new iMac computers were purchased for the computer lab and 10 additional wireless laptops were added for classroom use. The Kindergarten received new flooring. In addition, new textbooks were purchased for grades 4-8 in Math, Science, Spanish and Language Arts.

There are approximately 335 students currently enrolled in SPBS, with a faculty and staff of 35 for the 2011-2012 school year. This is the 49th year St. Paschal Baylon School has been providing excellence in Catholic education to Catholic students in the Conejo Valley!
